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Announcing a \$35,000 donation to Dr. Kathy Warren



Dr. Warren is an internationally recognized expert in pediatric neuro-oncology. She was appointed Clinical Director of Pediatric Neuro-Oncology at Dana-Farber/Boston Children's in 2019 and was previously Senior Investigator and head of the Neuro-Oncology Section in the Pediatric Oncology branch of the National Cancer Institute where she worked for more than 25 years. Her major

focus is developing new therapeutics to improve the outcome and quality of life for children with CNS tumors. Her work focuses on rational, pharmacokinetic-based drug development for children with brain tumors, and she is a leading innovator in developing new means of drug delivery. Her clinical trials have led the field in exploring new approaches for the treatment of children with these diseases.

Funding for Dr. Warren's research has been drastically cut back due to COVID-19, and in response, Liv Like a Unicorn Foundation is immensely proud to share that we have donated \$35,000 to fund the acquisition of a cell line, which will be instrumental in furthering her great work. In addition, the Foundation has committed to donate another \$40,000 by the end of this year. The generous support of our many donors makes these incredible donations possible, which will continue to move the needle in the effort to find a cure for pediatric brain and spinal cord cancers.

The 2nd Annual Clothing Drive

Patches for Jaxson

It all started with a simple request: police patches for a little boy named Jaxson. Jaxson was diagnosed with ATRT brain cancer right after



his first birthday, and went into remission after 1½ years of treatment. In February of this year, a routine MRI showed the cancer had returned. Liv like a Unicorn jumped on board to put a smile on this littler warrior's face. One simple Facebook post requesting patches was shared 759 times! Our foundation was able to deliver hundreds of patches from all over the country, as well as some from other countries. Thanks to all of your support, the family also received gift baskets for Jaxson's big brothers, meal vouchers, gift cards, and a check for \$2,000 to help cover the family's ongoing expenses. 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Did you know?

For every \$1 the government gives, less than 5 cents go towards pediatric cancer research.
Out of that, less than 2 cents go towards brain tumor research.

The average age of diagnosis for pediatric cancer is 5.

The causes of most childhood cancers are unknown and are not strongly linked to lifestyle or environmental risk factors, unlike many adult cancers.

Children who pass from pediatric cancer lose, on average, about 70 years of life, while adults, on average, lose about 15 years.

Victory 4 Vincent

Vincent is a 2 ½ year old little boy who has been battling. Atypical Tertoid Rhabdoid Tumors (AT/RT) which is a rare and aggressive form of brain cancer since he was 4 months old. Originally our



foundation jumped on board to send Vincent and his family on a cross-country road trip. Unfortunately Vincent's latest scans showed another tumor growing in his brain, so their trip was indefinitely postponed. Our foundation wanted to support their family and put a smile on Vincent and his sister Mina's face. Thanks to of your support, a few days before Vincent was scheduled for his 8th brain surgery, our team was able to deliver gift baskets for both children, gift cards and a check for \$2,000 to cover some of the families expenses.
